

DIRECTIONS FROM AIRPORTS TO BERKELEY

FROM SAN FRANCISCO AIRPORT: Travel time: 1 hour minimum.

Van Shuttles: (4:30 am to 10:00pm)

When you go outside the terminal (outside the baggage claim) you will see a strip of bus shelters with two traffic lanes on either side. Go to this traffic island on departure level. There are uniformed persons here who coordinate shuttle bus travel. Tell one of these persons that you want the Bay Porter Express (green vans). The clerk will line you up for one of these shuttles. The wait is usually brief.

The Bay Porter Express costs **\$25.00** per person door-to-door to your Berkeley destination, leaving every half hour. If possible, it is best to call ahead of time to reserve a place: 510-864-4000, but this is not necessary.

BART Train: (Monday-Friday 4:30am to 12:00 Midnight; Saturday 6:00am to Midnight; Sunday 8:00am to Midnight)

If you can be picked up at the Downtown Berkeley BART station or don't mind taking a Taxi, riding the train is a more economical option. At the airport, follow the signs to BART and take the Pittsburg/Bay Point train. You need to purchase your ticket before riding the train. You must transfer at the *12th St. Oakland City Center* station to a Richmond bound train. Your final stop will be the *Downtown Berkeley* station. The one-way train fair will be approximately **\$5.50** and the Taxi fair should be less than **\$5.00**.

*Make sure to listen to the announcements and read the reader boards in case there have been any unexpected train changes. Also, try to have close to exact change available.

FROM OAKLAND AIRPORT: Travel time: About 45 minutes.

Van Shuttles: (4:30 am to 10:00pm)

Bay Porter Express: If you are flying into Oakland, it is best to have reservations with Bay Porter Express because they do not have a staff person outside the terminal. You can make a reservation by calling 510-864-4000. When you get to the airport, call Bay Porter at 864-4000, and they tell you where to get the van. The cost is **\$21.00** per person, door-to-door to your Berkeley destination, leaving every hour on the hour.

BART Train: (Monday-Friday 4:30am to 12:00 Midnight; Saturday 6:00am, and Sunday 8:00am to 12:00 Midnight)

If you can be picked up at the Downtown Berkeley BART station or you don't mind taking a Taxi, riding the train is a more economical option. At the airport, exit the building near baggage claim and look for signs for the Air-BART Shuttle. You will take a very short ride to the BART station where you will catch the Richmond bound train. You need to purchase your ticket before riding the train. Your final stop will be the *Downtown Berkeley* station. The airport shuttle cost is **\$2.00**, the BART fair to Berkeley will be approximately **\$1.90**, and the Taxi fare should be less than **\$5.00**.

*Make sure to listen to the announcements and read the reader boards in case there have been any unexpected train changes. Also, try to have close to exact change available.
